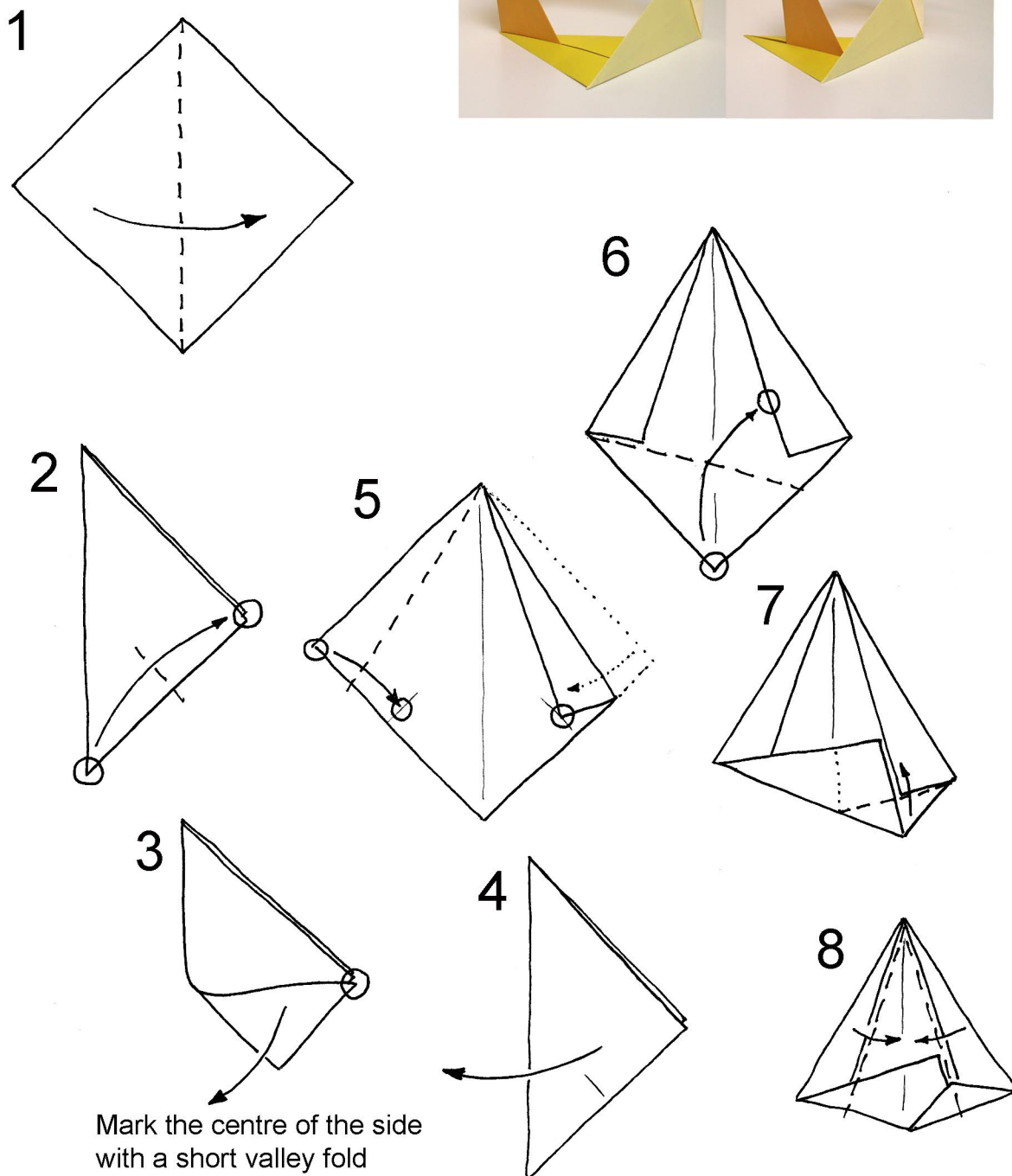
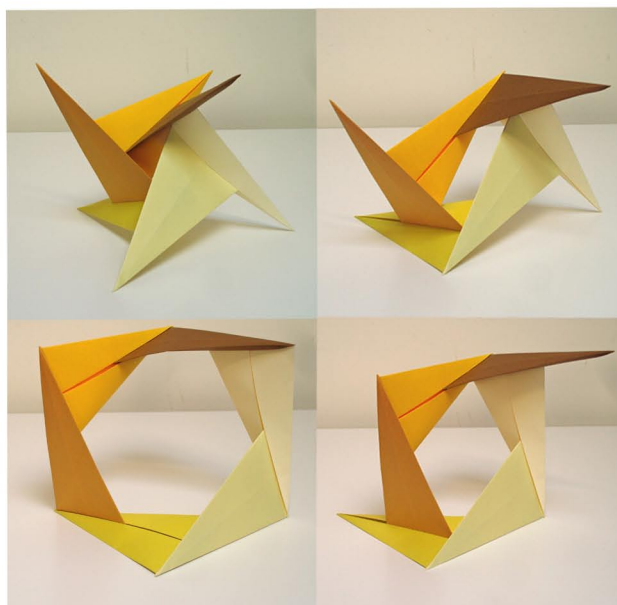


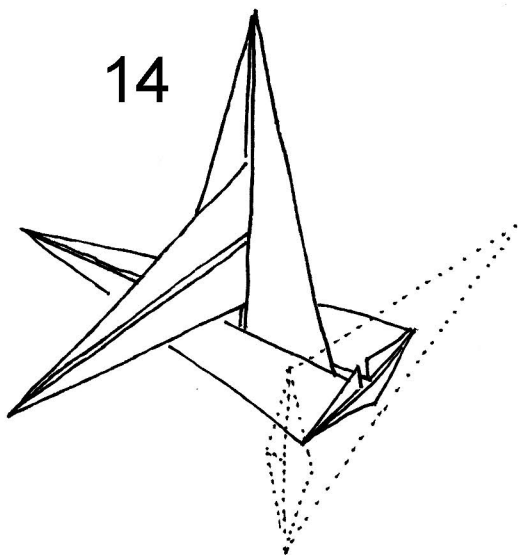

a moveable six unit construction

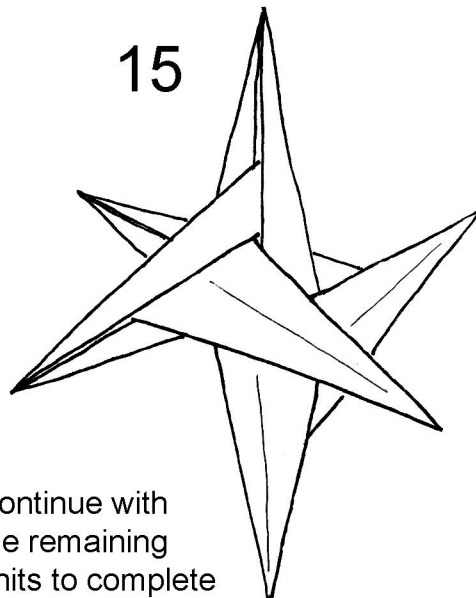
Use 15cm squares

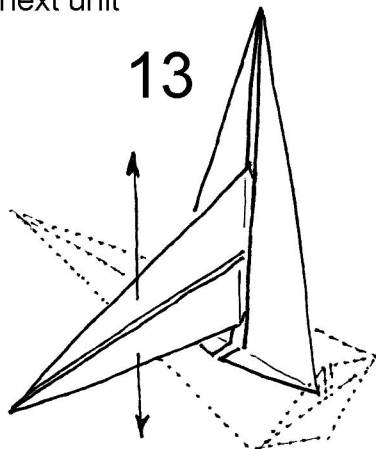




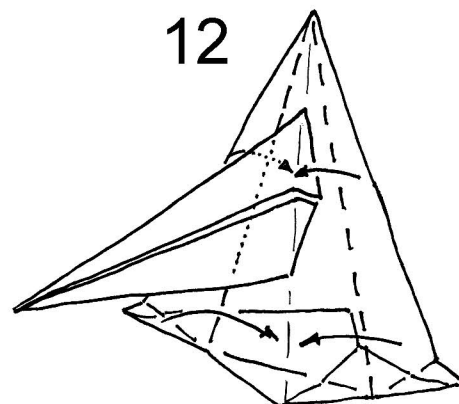
Dotted lines show the position of the next unit



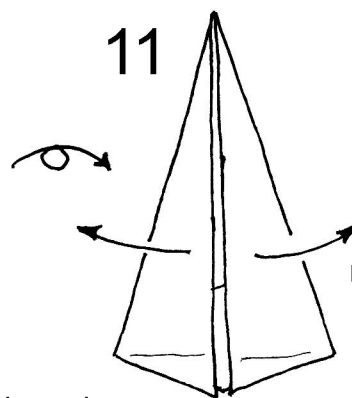
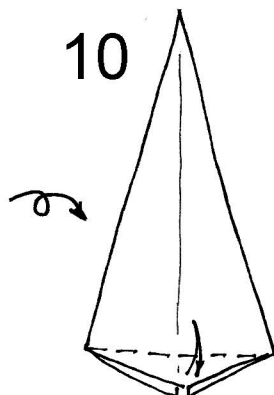
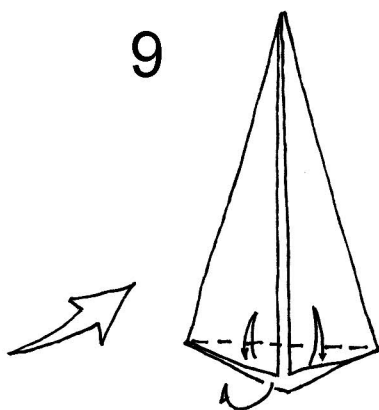
Continue with the remaining units to complete the construction

How to connect two units

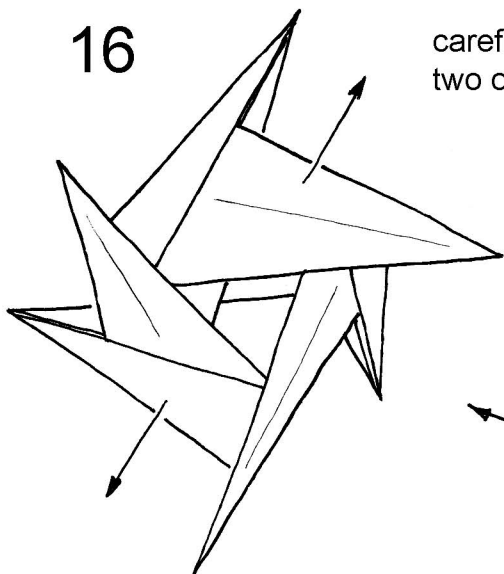


make six units

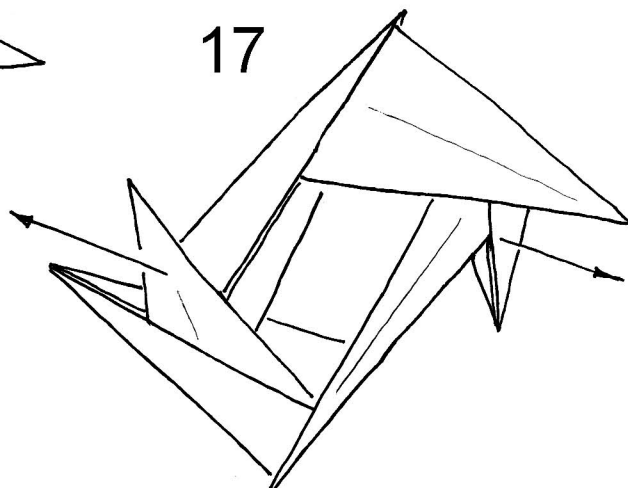
Crease firmly, open and refold, ensuring the tabs will easily flex forwards and backwards

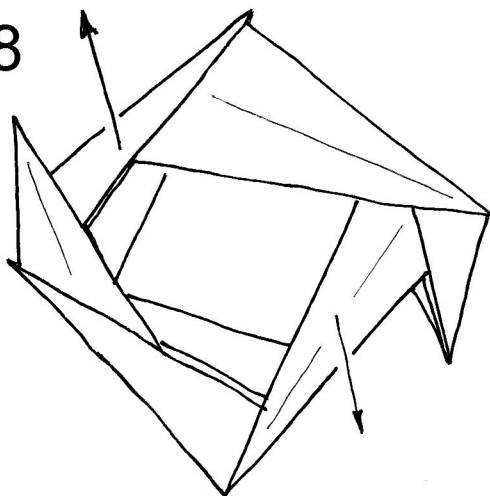
carefully side apart  
two opposite units



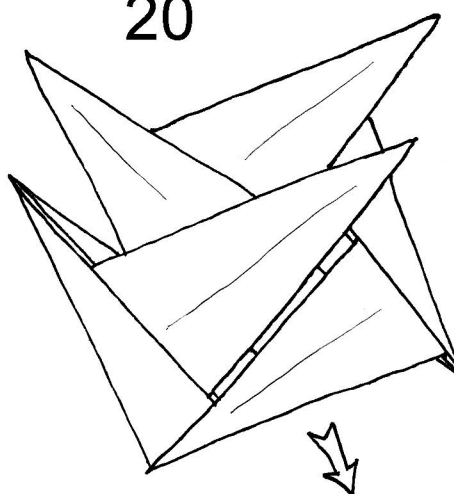

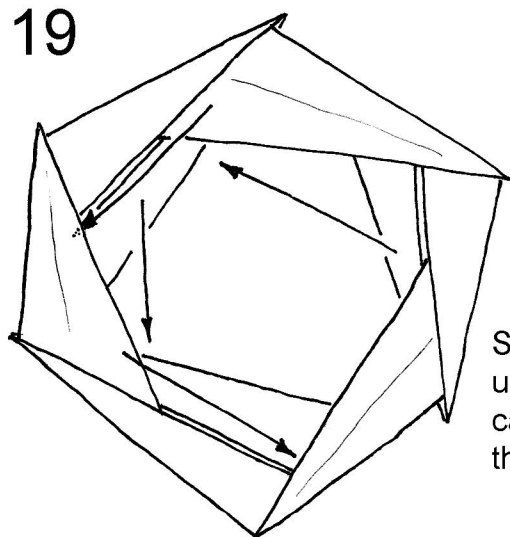
